CHOICES FOR TOUR

- If selecting May 1, 2027 to depart, you will be staying at the Hyatt Regency Chicago for an additional cost of \$340/day/room for 2 additional pre-tour nights; Collette will book hotel. It will allow this group to explore and experience more of Chicago's interesting sights, restaurants, shows, etc. at their own pace and schedule.
- If you only want to experience the Collette tour, when booking advise Collette you want to depart for Chicago on May 3, 2027.

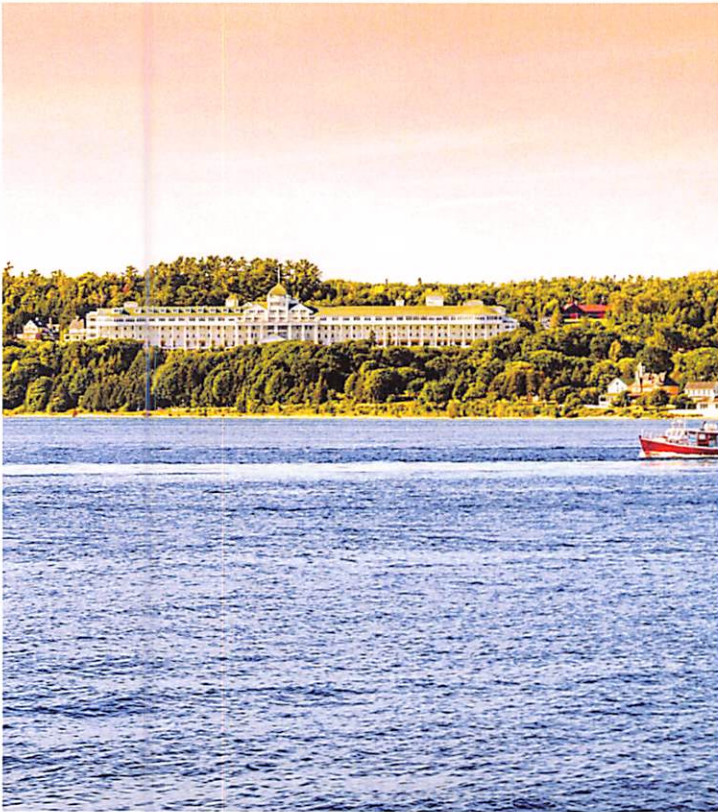
CHOICES FOR BOOKING AIR

- If you want to use Collette's air package, it includes these transfers for no additional cost. Also, covered by Travel Protection, if purchased for \$469.
 - Hometown Transfer (hometown to airport)
 - Arrival Transfer (in-destination airport to hotel)
 - Departure Transfer (in-destination hotel to airport)
 - Hometown Transfer (airport to hometown)
- If you want to book your own air, Collette's Travel Protection will **not** cover your air; only the tour, if you purchase.
 - Will not include Hometown Transfers to/from airport
 - Arrival/Departure hotel transfers are not included, but can be purchased for \$75/person for each.
 - For transfers, if using Uber, Lyft, etc., recommend booking ahead of time for obtaining required size of vehicle (SUV, multi-passenger van, etc.) and best price.
 - O'Hare to Hyatt Regency approximately 18-20 miles
 - Hilton Garden Inn to Detroit Metro Airport approximately 20-22 miles
 - Some credit cards offer Travel Protection, which could be used when purchasing your air.

Passengers who book their own air should provide Collette with their full air booking details to aid Collette with logistics and communication.

A deposit of \$698 (plus \$469, if purchasing Travel Protection) per person is due upon reservation. Reservations are made on a first come, first served basis; we have 16 seats held until reduction date. Reservations made after the seat reduction date of October 27, 2026, are based upon availability. Final payment due by February 02, 2027. Deposits are refundable up until November 03, 2026.

Day 1: Saturday, May 1, 2027 Arrive Chicago, Illinois Your tour begins today. Get ready for a relaxing journey through the tranquil beauty of Mackinac Island and the Great Lakes region. This stunning landscape comes alive amid old-fashioned traditions.

Day 2: Sunday, May 2, 2027 Chicago Enjoy time to get to know the place where your journey begins.

Day 3: Monday, May 3, 2027 Chicago Enjoy another day of leisure to explore this great city on your own.

Day 4: Tuesday, May 4, 2027 Chicago Begin your day with a locally guided tour of Chicago's remarkable and impressive architecture. This dynamic city goes by many names including "Second City" and "The Windy City," but no matter what you call it, you're sure to fall in love. Highlights of your tour include famous Michigan Avenue, the "Magnificent Mile," the Wrigley Building, the Loop, the Lakefront, and a walking tour through Millennium Park. Arriving back to the hotel around 1 p.m., the remainder of your day is at leisure. You may want to visit one of Chicago's many museums, relax during a scenic boat ride across the Chicago River, or visit the Chicago Cultural Center. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner. (B, D)

Day 5: Wednesday, May 5, 2027 Chicago - Holland, Michigan - Grand Rapids This morning, you will depart Chicago and make your way to Holland, Michigan, to celebrate the Tulip Time Festival. After an included lunch, a local guide* will show off the town's beautiful floral displays while also giving you the history of this celebration dating back to 1929. Your tour will end with time to explore the Windmill Island Gardens and discover a palette of color that spreads across 36 acres of manicured gardens, dikes, and canals. You can also see the only authentic Dutch windmill operating in the United States. Later, arrive in the nearby city of Grand Rapids for an evening at your leisure. (B, L)

Day 6: Thursday, May 6, 2027 Grand Rapids - Mackinac Island This morning, enjoy a scenic drive before arriving in Mackinac City at the tip of Michigan's lower peninsula. You will have some time to explore this coastal vacation town and grab lunch before boarding the ferry that will take you back to a simpler time on Mackinac Island. Upon arrival, listen for how the neighs of horses replace the roar of engines. Your home for the next two nights is the glorious Victorian-era resort, the Grand Hotel.** Both your hotel and the island itself are National Historic Landmarks. The island is a natural gem with over eighty percent of its land preserved by Mackinac State Park, a woodland paradise accented with limestone formations and ringed by Lake Huron. After dinner*** at your hotel, the evening is yours to enjoy. Perhaps you'll take a leisurely stroll through the quaint village or relax on the Grand Hotel's famous porch. (B, D)

Day 7: Friday, May 7, 2027 Mackinac Island Climb aboard your horse-drawn carriage for an island tour that includes stops at the Surrey Hills Carriage Museum and Arch Rock. Following your tour, savor some time to enjoy all of Mackinac Island's quiet pleasures. Enjoy brilliant views while sitting on the front porch of the Grand Hotel or take a walk downtown to visit the shops and buy some fudge, a favorite item on the island. Later, choose from a menu of tasty delicacies when you dine at the elegant Salle à Manger. After dinner, enjoy a cup of coffee while listening to the refined sounds of the Grand Hotel's orchestra. If you crave a secluded hideaway, retreat to the charming Cupola Bar. (B, D)

Day 8: Saturday, May 8, 2027 Mackinac Island - Bay City Enjoy some leisure time at the Grand Hotel and in town before departing this afternoon for your riverfront accommodations in Bay City. This evening is at leisure. Perhaps you will head to the river walk where you can explore the downtown on your own. (B)

Day 9: Sunday, May 9, 2027 Bay City - Detroit Today, explore the architectural artistry of Alden B. Dow's home and studio during a guided tour. This legendary 20th century architect designed his home to be the peak of Mid-Twentieth Century Modern Architecture, and since its construction has been declared a National Historic Landmark. Continue your journey to Detroit, a city with a soul as deep as its history – where roaring engines, Motown melodies, and bold architecture tell stories of resilience and reinvention. After dropping luggage off at the hotel, step into a fascinating chapter of the city's past as you explore Detroit's colorful history. From Prohibition-era speakeasies to legendary mob families and the lawmen who chased them, you'll uncover tales woven into the fabric of Detroit's streets and landmarks. This evening, enjoy dinner on your own. (B)

Day 10: Monday, May 10, 2027 Detroit - Dearborn - Detroit Today we visit Dearborn, hometown of Henry Ford and the Ford Motor Company. At the Henry Ford Museum, learn how the automobile forever changed American life and society. Then explore the evolution of American manufacturing and get a peek at where the infamous Ford F-150 is assembled at Rouge Factory. During your farewell dinner this evening, get ready to be immersed in Detroit's musical legacy as a passionate local musician shares sounds and stories of Motown legends, jazz greats, and the creative forces that shaped the city. (B, D)

Day 11: Tuesday, May 11, 2027 Detroit - Tour Ends Your tour ends today, leaving you with a bounty of happy memories from your visit to America's heartland. (B)

Experience It! The Grand Hotel

Stay for two nights in one of North America's most impressive hotels — the legendary Grand Hotel on Mackinac Island. Built during America's Gilded Age, the Grand Hotel is an elegantly designed Victorian lodge made from Michigan white pine. The grand opening of the Grand Hotel took place on July 10, 1887 with room rates starting at \$3.00 a night. Guests arrive and depart the hotel by horse-drawn carriage — a romantic and whimsical nod to a simpler era. As you approach the majestic manor, the first thing you'll notice is the hotel's seemingly endless front porch. At 600 feet in length, it is the longest porch in the world. Five U.S. Presidents — Bill Clinton, George H. W. Bush, Gerald Ford, John Kennedy, and Harry Truman — have all stayed at the Grand Hotel. The 1979 motion picture, *Somewhere in Time*, in which Christopher Reeve's and Jane Seymour's characters found love across time, was filmed here. Every October, fans of the film gather at the hotel for a weekend. Esther Williams' 1949 film, *This Time for Keeps*, was also shot at the hotel. The heated 220 foot, serpentine shaped, 500,000-gallon swimming pool is named in her honor. Your stay at this historic landmark is sure to be the highlight of your trip!

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 1. This means you're a leisurely traveler. You typically take it easy and discover the energy of a new place by people-watching or soaking in the atmosphere at a local café. You can climb at least one flight of stairs, board a coach, and walk unassisted at a relaxed pace for up to 60 minutes without difficulty. You can easily handle altitudes up to 5,000 feet.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

Accessing the horse-drawn carriages in Mackinac Island will require mounting 2-3 steep steps.

To fully enjoy certain stops on this tour, such as Chicago, please be prepared for periods of walking or standing that may last up to 1.5 hours. During your self-guided visit to the Henry Ford Museum, you'll have approximately 4 hours to explore, which involves walking or standing at your own pace.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Personal audio devices (headsets) are not included on this tour.

*The Tulip Time Festival typically runs from the first Saturday in May to the second Saturday in May. Exact dates for the Tulip Time Festival are released 7 months prior to the festival date. Due to festival scheduling, certain dates may not have guided tours available during your visit. If your departure falls on a date where local guides are not available, you will have a self-guided visit to the Tulip Immersion Garden which has been designed by world-renowned Dutch horticulturist Ibo Gulsen and will feature 65,000 tulips of all varieties.

***The Grand Hotel experience includes dressing up for dinner. After 6:30 p.m., ladies should wear a dress, skirt and blouse, or pantsuit, and gentlemen are required to wear a coat and necktie. Evening wear is required in all areas of the hotel except the Cupola Bar, where casual dress is acceptable at any time.

**The Grand Hotel officially opens in early May. Some dates could end up arriving at the hotel during the soft opening period, which may result in limited services. Grand opening dates are determined after this tour is released for sale.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of purchasing these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.
